## **Observance of World Environment Day**



# Report on Vermi Compost Tank for Waste Management Vijay Memorial College of Education, Barsu Bagla

**Date: 9 July 2024** 

### Introduction

Vijay Memorial College of Education has taken a significant step towards sustainable waste management by setting up a vermi compost tank. This initiative aims to reduce organic waste, create a nutrient-rich fertilizer, and promote eco-friendly practices on campus.






