A panel of esteemed judges evaluated the projects based on innovation, practicality, and presentation skills. The best projects were awarded certificates and trophies to recognize students' efforts.


Conclusion



Report on Extension Activity Naina Devi Temple at Palyani Village



Report on Composite Regional Centre Sunder Nagar Visit on March 19th, 2025
